RE: WYATT receives timely boost from Rawlco Radio 10K20 program

Saskatoon: Saskatoon's Wyatt (Singer-songwriter/guitarists Daniel Fortier and Scott Patrick) has been selected to receive \$10,000 as part of Rawlco Radio's 10K20 program. Wyatt begins recording this summer in Regina with Juno Award Winning singer-songwriter Jason Plumb (The Waltons, Jason Plumb and the Willing) as producer.

With major industry events like the Juno's, Canadian Country Music Awards and Western Canadian Music Week all coming to Saskatchewan in 2007, the timing of Rawlco Radio is impeccable. Says Scott Patrick, 'This money allows us to start from an enviable place in the music industry. We have creative control, industry buy-in, and the money to get things off on the right footing. The timing of Rawlco Radio's 10K20 program could not have been better for us. It comes at a time when we, as emerging artists, need that injection of money to step us up to that next level.'

In November 2005, WYATT released 'Snowed In', a limited edition CD of Christmas music within Saskatchewan to raise money for their debut album project. The album of Christmas songs received very favorable reviews from the Saskatoon Star Phoenix and industry people including Jay Semko of the Northern Pikes. The album did very well selling 400 copies in only 3 1/2 weeks! Says Fortier, "The album just took off from word of mouth and touring. The whole goal of the album was to break even this year, and make money on it in the following year to put towards recording projects. As it was, we were able to start recording in January!" Fortier adds, "To receive the support of a radio network that believes in the talent within this province enough to make a direct investment in it is really liberating. Most importantly, combined with our own contributions, it gives us leverage when applying for other investment from both the public and private sectors."

Wyatt is already into preproduction on the album. Fans are encouraged to check out the Wyatt website and blog for MP3's, pictures and news as the album progresses.
